



SUMMER MUSICAL AGES 9-15

Our summer auditions-only musical day camp stages a junior version of a full Broadway musical. We hold auditions in the Spring and the camp itself runs for three weeks in July, Monday-Friday, 9am-4pm. Children learn songs, choreography, and lines while preparing for a full weekend of (generally sold-out) performances on our mainstage, with sets, lights, and costumes.

SUMMER SHAKESPEARE AGES 12-18

For older youth ages 12-18, our auditions-only Shakespeare day camp is a great experience, running for three weeks in August, Monday-Friday, 12pm-4:30pm. Teens help choose the concept and setting of the production, learn classical theatre techniques and history, and contribute to costumes, sets, and makeup designs, all while staging a 90-minute cut of one of Shakespeare's famous plays. They'll also experience a smattering of basic stage combat, early modern stagecraft, and the ever-popular Blood Day! The camp culminates in a pair of weekend performances on our mainstage.





Lovers, fairies, and clowns inhabit this, the most magical of Shakespeare's comedies. With plenty of opportunities for wacky hijinks, fantastical makeup and costumes, and fun special effects, this play is always a big hit with actors and audiences alike.

SCHOLARSHIPS AND FINANCIAL AID

PARKS AND RECREATION SCHOLARSHIPS

All of our youth (and adult!) theatre classes, camps, afterschool programs, and workshops are eligible for the city-wide <u>Parks and Rec Scholarship Program</u>. Filling out the application can provide qualified applicants with \$150 per person in your family per year towards registration costs. Award applications are currently being accepted for Fiscal Year 2023-2024 (available to use July 1, 2023 through June 30, 2024).

These funds can be applied towards the cost of our 2024 summer day camps, as long as registrations are processed prior to June 30, 2024.

PARKS AND RECREATION SUMMER CAMP PAYMENT PLANS

To increase access to Camp programming for Summer 2024, payment plan options are available and can be selected at the time of registration. Parks and Rec Payment Plans will allow families to enroll in camp programming and manage payment scheduling to meet their needs. Our policy requires all customers to have an active credit or debit card on file.

Because the cost of Parks and Rec programs are subsidized only for residents of the City of Corvallis, we recognize that increased costs for out-of-city registrations can be daunting for Benton County residents who live in Philomath, Monroe, North Albany, and other local cities and townships. Due to generous support from the Benton Community Foundation, the Majestic Theatre is able to offer scholarships to out-of-city Benton County youth towards the cost of any youth theatre program.
